

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All exhibits shown must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
2. All birds to be penned by 9.30am. Judging commences 10am prompt. Boxing may commence at 4pm. No birds to leave the tent until all are accounted for.
3. We are sorry but we will only accept entries on time in writing and with the full entry fee.
4. In the event of any one bird or exhibitor in the class the show reserves the right to amalgamate within its breed class / colour or any other variety class.
5. All birds are to be fed and watered by exhibitors after judging has taken place.
6. All exhibitors are to park vehicles to the rear of the poultry tent.
7. All eggs must be fresh and the produce of the exhibitor. The bleaching of eggs or any artificial preparation of the same will disqualify the entry.
8. A poultry pass will be issued to all exhibitors with entries 8 and above, S.A.E. is to be enclosed with entries for this pass.
9. If the Judge wishes the tent to be closed for judging, it will be CLOSED.
10. All exhibitor must be registered with the Animal and Plant Health Agency on the GB poultry register and the keeper of any birds attending the gathering will need to provide evidence of registration before being granted entry i.e. by stating their County-Parish-Holding Number (CPH).
11. The valid CPH number will need to be written on the AVIAN INFLUENZA & NEWCASTLE DISEASE PARTICIPANT DECLARATION FORM an the form to be handed to the secretary the morning of show.
