1. Exhibitors can begin staging their items from 8am. All exhibits must be staged by 10.30am, with judging commencing at 11am.
2. Prize money can be collected from 4.30pm and no entries should be removed from the tent before this time. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to collect their items at the end of the day.
3. Entries received by Saturday 28th June are priced at 50p per exhibit. This payment should be made with the entry form found in this schedule. Entries amounting to more than £10 will be sent a free entry pass. This is limited to one per person.
4. Entries on show day are priced at £1 per exhibit. Please see the steward in the tent to make your payment.
5. Cheques are to be made payable to Machen Agricultural Show.
6. Utmost care will be taken of the exhibits, but the committee will not be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
7. Any trophies can be kept for one year and must be returned by show day the following year.
