3. Entries received by Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> June are priced at 50p per exhibit. This payment should be made with the entry form found in this schedule. Entries amounting to more than £10 will be sent a free entry pass. This is limited to one per person.
4. Entries on show day are priced at £1 per exhibit. Please see the steward in the tent to make your payment.
5. Cheques are to be made payable to Machen Agricultural Show.
6. Utmost care will be taken of the exhibits, but the committee will not be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
7. Any trophies can be kept for one year and must be returned by show day the following year.
