National Pony Society (NPS)

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and nonmembers but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1 st – 3 rd August 2023. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

Welsh Pony and Cob Society (WP&CS)

This show is affiliated to the Welsh Pony and Cob Society. **Affiliation No AF000139.** Animals must be entered correctly in line with the rules, detailed in the WPCS Judging and Showing Handbook which can be found on the Society website www.wpcs.uk.com or requested from the WPCS office. Failure to comply with the rules may result in the withholding of awards.

2.3 Classes must be confined to SPS-BS registered ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.

2.4 Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show.

2.5 To enter a stallion in ANY class (in-hand or performance) at an affiliated show, entire males aged 4 years old and over must have an "S" number and have been successfully through either the SPS-BS Stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPS-BS Voluntary Veterinary Examination. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In hand colts/stallions of two years old or over must be shown bitted and are advised to display a colt or stallion bridle badge, these are available to purchase from the SPS-BS.

2.6 There must be no colts or stallions in Young Handlers classes. Young Handlers must be a minimum of 3 years of age on the day of the show. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or Stallions in In-hand classes. Children aged under 12 years old on the day of their class may not show a stallion in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats conforming to current British Safety standards must be worn, correctly secured, by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-hand classes. For Health & Safety purposes judges and exhibitors must remain standing whilst in the ring when showing ponies. KNEELING IS NOT PERMITTED. Hard hats conforming to current British Safety standards must be worn, correctly secured, by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old or over. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

Class 27 TATTERSALLS RoR AMATEUR RIDDEN SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER 2025

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited.

The Series is open to AMATEUR riders only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration.

Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the final. Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 2025

RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a RoR branded prize to the winner to be redeemed from the RoR Office. The winner also qualifies for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24th August 2024. A branded prize will be presented to the highest placed Veteran horse (15+) and qualification to the RoR Ridden Veteran Final also at Aintree on 24th August 2024. Prize to be redeemed from the RoR Office.

Amateur definition:

The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition, a person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:

Engage(d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st 2023. Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season. SSADL Home Produced Qualifiers are OPEN to both Members and Non-Members of SSADL No Spurs with the exception to senior side saddle riders, No Galloping or canter extensions, No wearing of Face/Body Jewellery with the exception to the ear ring used by competitors with health problems. Foals are NOT permitted SSADL Classes. For In-Hand Classes - Minimum age of handler = 11 years old. First Ridden ponies/riders will be asked after the initial walk round to come into the centre of the ring. First Ridden Competitors will only canter in their individual shows. Lead Rein Riders/First Ridden competitors: If a strip section is required a lead rein rider MUST stay mounted.

STALLIONS - Either for In Hand or Ridden classes, Competitors Must be 16 years of age or over. Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same from qualifier to Grand Finals, unless special circumstances should arise, then it will be left to the discretion of the Directors and Advisory Committee to oversee this rule if required.

ALL COMPETITORS SHOULD AQUAINT THEMSELVES WITH SSADL RULES BEFORE ENTERING. SSADL Rulebook can be found at www.seniorshowinganddressage.co.uk

2024 Qualification System: SSADL Members will receive their own qualification card. This is to be signed in the at time of judging/presentation. This is the members' responsibility to ensure the right qualifier is signed for.

1. 1st to 6th in each age group will qualify for the London International Horse Show 2nd round qualifiers 2024.
2. 1st to 6th from each AGE section will qualify for the SSADL

Members Open Challenge. (Lead Rein Ponies are NOT permitted) Open to all types and Breeds.

Members Mountain and Moorland Challenge. (Lead Rein Ponies are NOT permitted)

Members Foreign Breeds Challenge.

3. The 6 highest placed Lead/or First Ridden **Members Lead Rein/First Ridden Challenge**
4. 1st – 3rd in each age group will qualify for the **Senior of Year Championship**

(If a competitor has already qualified the qualification can be passed down the line).

Once a member has filled out their qualification card to the relevant classes then said card must be sent into the Office by normal post no later than the 30th August 2024. REMEBER TO PHOTOCOPY YOUR CARD.

Non – Members Qualification cards will be handed out in the ring to the six highest placed competitors in each section these are for Non-Members ONLY

Qualification cards MUST be returned to SSADL Head Office within the 10-day period of date of show along with a 2024 Membership application completed and payment made. Once a qualification card/membership is sent in correctly along with payment, only **then** will Members be eligible for the Members Challenge Preliminary rounds and Challenge Finals, to be held at the SSADL National Championship Show on the 21st & 22nd September 2024 at Onley Grounds, Rugby, Warwickshire.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Committee reserve the right to exclude any person from the show if they deem it fit.
2. Any exhibitor lodging a protest must first deposit 40 pounds (£40) with the Secretary which will be forfeited to the funds if the claim is not sustained. All protests must be in writing and received within 1 hour of the class.
3. The Secretary must report any protests or disputes to the Show committee whose decision on the day will be final. In case of an objection being sustained against any entry, the prize will be given to the next in merit, if commended by the judge.
4. In the event of the need for a referee judge, that judges decision will be taken as final.
5. The Committee will not be responsible for any incident arising from any cause connected with the Show and it shall be a condition of entry. This rule will be strictly enforced.
6. Competitors are strongly advised to have adequate public liability insurance in place.
7. Riders of horses should wear hats which conform to the relevant British Standard for the activity.
8. Competitors are strongly urged to ensure that their horses are up to date with their vaccinations and in general good health.
9. Any persons infringing the rules will be excluded from the Show.
10. The Committee reserve the right of refusing entry, cancelling or altering the classes and arrangements of the programme, of postponing the Show in the event of unfavourable weather or any unforeseen circumstances.
11. All class times are approximate and it is your responsibility to ensure that you are on time for your class.
12. All horse and pony prize monies to be collected from the Horse Secretary.
13. All entries to be Paid in Full before the closing dates. Entries on the day will be cash only.
14. No entry fees will be refunded on the Show Day without a current vet's certificate.
15. The Committee will not pay for any engraving on cups or trophies.
16. In the event of cancellation exhibitors from all sections will receive a 50% refund.
17. DATA PROTECTION It is a condition of entry that the Machen Show Society reserves the right to forward Exhibitor information to the press, Breed and Showing Societies and other regulatory authorities (i.e.DEFRA or Trading Standards).
18. The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the HEALTH AND SAFETY of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

SHOW CODES OF SAFETY

The Members and Committee of Machen Agricultural Society wish to state the following conditions which apply during preparation for the Show during the event itself and while exhibitions are being dismantled. All exhibitors, retailers, caterers, equipment suppliers, event organisers and members of the public should ensure that they comply with all current Health and Safety Executive Legislation and Guidelines and in particular.

1. Note should be taken of all Showground signs with special notice to be paid to those denoting areas which access is restricted to members of the public, and / or animals and vehicles.
2. No gas appliance or portable generators may be used on the Show field that have not been recently examined and tested by a competent person. Appliances used should be labelled to indicate the examiner's name and date of examination.
3. Persons who supply or loan equipment for use by the organisers or members of the public must ensure that it complies fully with current legislation and standards relevant to its proposed use, and that it is properly maintained.
4. Any steam or Pressure vessel or lifting appliance used or demonstrated must have undergone a recent inspection, should be labelled accordingly and should be appropriately insured.
5. Fairground devices (including all passenger carrying rides) are only allowed on the basis that the code of Safe Practice at Fairs' has been observed and understood by all operators.
(b) Any use of equipment by persons under the age of 13 years of age is prohibited.
6. Any accident or injuries should be reported immediately to the Secretary's tent, where First Aid will be available.
7. Access to Show Rings is restricted to persons involved in the organisations of the event and exhibitors/competitors.
8. All emergency access routes will be clearly indicated and should not be obstructed by vehicles at any time.
9. All exhibitors and competitors should be aware of the Show Committee's Health and Safety policy statement, copies of which are available in advance or in the Secretary's tent on Show day. Anyone who breaks the rules of the Society or contravenes any of the conditions laid out in the Health and Safety policy Statement will be asked to leave the Showground.
